

B Y O D P O L I C Y

According to the GHS Student Handbook (page 19):

Cell phones are NOT to be used at any time in the classroom without direct permission from the teacher. Possession of a telephone or other electronic communication device by a student is a privilege which may be forfeited by any student who fails to abide by the terms of this guideline or otherwise engages in misuse of the privilege.

Unauthorized use of electronic devices is prohibited. Students may be allowed to possess cellular phones/electronic communication devices while on school property or while attending school-sponsored activities on or off school property as long as these devices are **silent and out of sight during instructional times.**

Use of any camera or other recording device is prohibited on school property and at school sponsored events without teacher or administrator permission.

Electronic devices are permitted in the Commons and hallway areas.

Students found to be in violation of this policy will be referred to the office and disciplined according to procedures listed in the Student Handbook.

Please understand that use of an electronic device in Green Local Schools is an optional activity and is in no way a requirement for students to participate. In addition, B.Y.O.D. is an academic privilege and, like all privileges, can be take away if abused. Electronic devices are used through wireless access, with each student being issued an individual log-in and password. This use will be monitored on a regular basis and wireless access can and will be shut off for those who misuse their devices.

Green Local Schools is **NOT RESPONSIBLE** for the lost, damaged, or stolen devices. *The District assumes no liability if these devices are broken, lost or stolen. Notices of this policy are posted in a central location of the school building, classrooms, and in the student handbook.*
