

CLASS MEETINGS – JANUARY 2019

PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING AS DISCUSSED IN OUR CLASS MEETINGS, AND SEE MR. BRIDENTHAL (11th & 12th) OR MR. ELLIOTT (9th & 10th) IF YOU HAVE ANY QUESTIONS OR CONCERNS.

1. PARKING PERMITS: You are required to have one *BEFORE* you begin driving to school. Please see Mrs. Hastings in the main office to obtain your permit. Applications are also available on the GHS website. Those found to be driving without a permit will be issued a Friday School and/or have their driving privileges revoked.

2. CHROMEBOOKS & CHARGERS: Remember to charge your Chromebook each night, and bring it (as well as your charger) to school each day.

- FIRST VIOLATION: Verbal Warning
- SECOND VIOLATION: Friday School
- THIRD VIOLATION & BEYOND: Administrative Discretion, forfeiture of borrowing rights
- WARNINGS DO NOT RESET AT THE SEMESTER

3. HALL PASSES: You are required to have one any time you are in the halls other than at class change. Leaving lunch requires a pass *IN ADVANCE* from a teacher.

4. DRESS CODE: It is your responsibility to know & follow the dress code found in the GHS Student Handbook (p. 18). No further warnings will be issued for the 2nd semester: consequences will be applied to anyone found to be in violation of the dress code.

5. ATTENDANCE: Plan accordingly, and know & understand the differences in the following:

- TARDY: Any time you sign in BEFORE 7:50 AM.
- HALF-DAY ABSENCE: Is charged if you sign in AFTER 7:50 AM.
- EXCUSED ABSENCE: By Ohio law, for illness/family emergency/death in the family ONLY.
- UNEXCUSED ABSENCE: Anything that does not fall into excused absence. Examples include (but are not limited to) oversleeping, alarm didn't go off, missed the bus, etc.

6. E-CIGARETTES & VAPING: Due to student health and safety concerns, the following policy will be effective at GHS going forward.

- If you are caught with or using an e-cigarette/vape/Juul, a suspension will be applied.
- All students will be charged by the Summit County Sheriff's Department if found to be in possession and/or using an e-cigarette of any type.
- All questions should be directed to your principal or Deputy Hart.

7. CAFETERIA EXPECTATIONS: It is your responsibility to keep the area on & around your table clean during and immediately after lunch. No trash should be left on tables. If you make a mess, clean it up or seek help from Mr. Law or a monitor if needed. You may not leave the Commons during lunch without obtaining a pass prior to your lunch period.

8. BULLYING & HARASSMENT: If you feel that you are being bullied or harassed, PLEASE report it to a trusted adult immediately so that we can assist you.
