

## Gifted Plans and Procedures

All students are screened, assessed, and identified in the areas of superior cognitive ability, specific academic ability, creativity, and visual and/or performing arts using <u>ODE approved assessment instruments</u>. The district ensures equal opportunity for all Green Local School students identified as gifted to receive services offered by the district.

## **Acceleration**

Early Entrance to Kindergarten as well as whole grade and subject acceleration are available to students meeting criteria set by ODE and specified through the board policy information listed below.

## Referral

Students may be referred for testing by contacting the building principal or the <u>advanced academic program</u> coordinator.

Upon receipt of referral, the district will notify parents/guardians within 30 days of the screening/assessment results. The district provides at least two opportunities per year for assessment, unless otherwise requested.

Screening and Assessment Plan (Ohio Revised Code Section 3324.03)

**Specific Academic Ability: Grades 2-8:** (NWEA MAP for reading and math)

Superior Cognitive and Creative Thinking Ability: Grades 2 and 5: InView

Visual and Performing Arts: Grades 7-12:

Portfolio or audition takes place in the fall or spring. ODE rubrics are used to identify. Gates and Scales are used to assess creativity

## Transfer

Prior gifted identification using an ODE Approved Assessment Tool will be recognized and services will be provided pending proper documentation. At the request of the guardian(s), student transfers will be screened within 90 days of transfer.

Withdrawal or Refusal (Ohio Revised Code Section 3324.06)

Written requests to withdraw or refuse services should be sent to the <u>advanced academic program coordinator</u> and school principal.

Written Education Plans (Ohio Revised Code Section 3324.03)

The district provides gifted services based upon the student's area of identification and need(s). This written education plan (WEP), will include the areas of identification, the services, goals, and staff members responsible for service. A copy is provided to the families and staff.
